Bennie Ray (Buddy) White passed away Monday, December 6, 2021 at home in Varney, WV. Buddy was 71 and for two years has been fighting kidney failure and heart trouble. He was taking dialysis treatments three days a week. After graduating from Matewan high school in 1969, Buddy entered the U.S. Air Force, after service he worked in the coal mines for over 30 years. Buddy was a proud member of the UMWA Local 1440 in Matewan, WV. Although he had mine foreman papers in WV and KY, he chose to stay in the union. He loved to watch the Matewan Tigers and Mingo Miners and was for all of the local teams as long as they weren't playing Matewan or Mingo. He loved traveling and he had been in every state in the U.S. plus many other countries. His favorite baseball team was the Big Red Machine, and Pete Rose was his Favorite player. Buddy is preceded in death by his father Ben White, sister, Linda White and his brother Bobby White. He is survived by his mother Ruby White of Varney, WV, brother, Danny White of Varney, WV, sisters, Joyce Upton of Jeffersonville, OH, and Patty Browning of Wellston, OH. Buddy had several nieces, nephews, and cousins who loved him dearly. One special great niece Alivia Faith Simpkins, whom he called out many times "that's my girl". 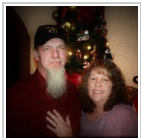
