



Rev. Bert R. Runyon

May 12, 1944 - March 3, 2016

Rev. Bert R. Runyon, Sr., age 71, of Marysville, died Thursday, March 3, 2016 at his home surrounded by his loving family. A minister for nearly all his life, he was pastor at Solid Foundation Pentecostal Church in Marion, Ohio more than 25 years. He also was former pastor at Lighthouse Church of God in Kenton, Tyler Street Mission in Marion and Full Gospel Fellowship Church in Delaware, Ohio. He was also an associate at Coughlin Auto Group in Marysville, Ohio. He was deeply devoted to his family, his friends and his congregations. 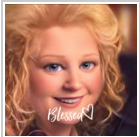
