April 2, 1945 - June 11, 2023

George Roger Clark “RC” Floyd was born on April 2, 1945, to Stewart and Rose Varney Floyd. He passed away peacefully on Sunday, June 11, 2023, at 9:57 PM at the Pikeville Medical Center, where he had valiantly fought the past few weeks.

RC’s story began at Delbarton, WV. At the age of just one-year-old, his father was tragically killed. His mother was remarried to Ribble C. Hatfield, who raised him as his own. This is why many who knew RC in his early life knew him as RC Hatfield.

At the age of seven years old, RC met the love of his life, Miss Viola Martin. Their journey as one started in junior high school and officially began on September 26, 1964. She would remain faithfully by his side for the next 59 years. They were both graduates of Magnolia High School class of 1964.

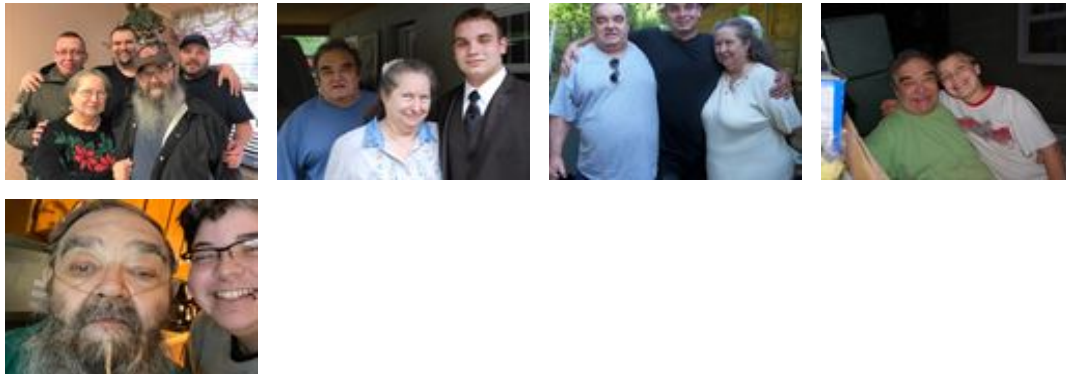
