Halcy Hatfield 75 of Elk Creek, WV went home to be with the Lord June 6, 2021 while a patient at the Appalachian Regional Hospital in South Williamson, KY. He was born September 28, 1945 in Huntington, WV the son of the late Taylor and Mate Farley Hatfield. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his wife, Eileene Hatfield, brothers, Ance, James, Eddie and Walker Hatfield and sister, Linda Thacker.

Halcy was dedicated to his family and community. He loved to help everyone he came in contact with. His passion was drag racing. During his racing career he set many records and was honored to be inducted into the NHRA Hall of Fame.

He proudly served in the US Army in Vietnam from 1965 to 1967. He was a proud Veteran. He also was a member of the Masonic Lodge Obrien 101 Williamson, WV, Scottish Rite and was an active member of the Beni Keedem Shrine in Charleston, WV where he worked closely with Make A Wish and the Shriners Hospital.

Halcy worked for more than 30 years before retiring at Hobet Mining at 22 Mine Road. He was a member of the UMWA Local 1440 Matewan, WV. From 2000 - 2006 he served as a Mingo County Commissioner. He loved his community & loved helping anyway he could. Halcy was also a Lee District Committeeman.
