Helen Smith Curry, 84, wife of Ray H. Curry, went home to be with her Heavenly Father on Thursday, March 5, 2015.

Born and raised in Williamson, WV, she was the daughter of Claude and Cordelia Baisden Smith, a well-known pioneer family of Williamson, WV. Helen was a 1948 graduate of Williamson High School and a graduate of The Huntington School of Beauty Culture. She operated Helen's Beauty Shop in Delbarton, WV.

On March 7, 1950, she married Ray Hardy Curry of Elk Creek Road in Delbarton, WV. She has been a resident of Elk Creek since that day. Helen is the Mother of two Sons, Richard Keith (Susan) Curry and the late David Ray Curry who passed away in an accident on July 12, 1980. She is the Grandmother of three Grandsons, David Ray Curry, Michael Jonathon Curry, and Billy Ray (LeeAnn) Curry, one granddaughter Chelsey Rae Curry, and two great-grandchildren, Autumn and Benjamin Curry.

Helen has been a proud member of Connolly Memorial Baptist Church since 1951 where she served her church in many capacities such as Associational Officer, Teacher, Deaconess, and Sunday School Superintendent. Her church family was her extended family.

She was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star Elizabeth Chapter No. 37 for more than 50 years. She has served her chapter well as Worthy Matron. She was also chosen as the Grand Representative of WV. She received the Grand Cross of Colors for her devotion to the Rainbow Girls which is one of the highest honors given. Helen's fondest memories were of her work with the Scouts where the meetings were held at her home. 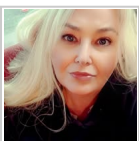

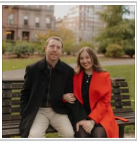
