Jack Crum 74 of Williamson formerly of Delbarton, WV, passed away Feb. 18, 2016 at the Williamson Memorial Hospital. He was born June 4, 1940 at Puritan Mines, WV the son of the late Mont and Maude Sparks Crum Jordan and step-father, Jum Jordan. He was also preceded in death by brothers, William Thomas and Ray Dean Crum and sister, Ann Marcum.

To his family and many friends, Jack was the life of the party. His sense of humor was unmatched. He always had a joke or funny prop to get the laughs roaring at family gatherings, especially for his mother, Maude. And oh, how he adored his mother. He was her treasure, and she, his life. He carried her purse as she shopped, and sat at her feet entertaining her with his stories and jokes, giving her boundless joy.

Jack left an amazing legacy in the world of Country Music. He got his start singing for his gospel group, The Revelators, in church. He left home for Nashville in the 1970's to pursue his dream of singing bass for his band, The Capitol City Boys. They achieved a top 40 hit on the Country Billboard Charts with their single, "A Little Ground in Texas". Jack's rich, deep voice was unmatched among bass singers of his time. And how he loved to sing in that low-range voice for the children of the family! They will never forget his rendition of "Juanita," everyone's favorite tune.

Jack passed that love of music to his son, Mark, who has achieved great success as a bass player and mainstay in modern Country music. Mark has played with the greats in the Grand Ole Opry, including Dottie West, Reba McEntire, Linda Davis, Johnny Paycheck, Darryl Worley, and, currently, Jamey Johnson. Also, his grandson Marshall (Bubby) Lowry is carrying on the tradition as the frontman and guitarist for The Marshall Lowry Band, their sound a mix of Bluegrass and Country. Their song, "Miles to Go" (and music video) has been very well-received.

With all this success in the music industry, Jack will be most remembered for his many jam sessions at the Delbarton Opry, "pickin' and grinnin' " with his brothers, Joe, Mont, and Don. Together, they organized many treasured nights of food, music, and fellowship for the whole town and beyond. Jack's lifelong love of music, friends, and family is the true legacy he leaves behind for all who knew and loved him.

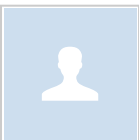
