John Stephen Cook, a loving Stevie, Dad and Paw went home to be with his Lord on January 8, 2018, while a patient at the WVU Heart Institute. He was surrounded by his loving family. He was born January 30, 1945, at Red Jacket, WV to the late Marie Savage and Theodore “Ted” Cook. He was also preceded in death by his siblings, Louise Thomas Moore and Ted “Buddy” Cooke.

At the early age of 16 his dad passed away. After that his mother Marie met and married his step-father, Gerald Chafin of Elk Creek and they moved to Delbarton. It was during this time that he found his job. For over 45 years our dad worked and owned Chafin Funeral Home. He loved his job and loved to serve the families in the Delbarton area. Also during this time, he drove a school bus for the Mingo County Board of Education. He drove number 28 for 27 years from Delbarton to Taylorville. Most importantly in his life, he became a Christian. With the persistency of our mother he was saved and baptized at the Regional Church of God. He loved his pastor, Mitchell Bias, and loved to hear Matt Hartley preach as well. When he was able to go he hardly missed a service. His happy place was being at home surrounded by his grandchildren giving them various projects to do around the property. He loved working with and raising his chickens.

On January 31st he would have celebrated his 54th anniversary with his high school sweetheart and the love of his life, Jane. She was by his side every day helping him through all of his hospital stays and doctors visits. She has

been his rock. He will be dearly missed by his four children, Lisa Williamson and Jim; Steven "Tib" and his wife Cindy; Jamie Cook and Gretchen; and Malena Woolum and her husband, Scott. Paw's 11 grandchildren were his pride and joy. Each has a special place in his heart. Chase and Vette Williamson; Cody Williamson & Cassie; Corey Cook & Kayla; Jordan Cook & Caitlin; Blake and Sabrina Cook; Hanna Cook & John; Dylan Woolum & Tori; Tanner Woolum; Garrett Cook; Hunter Woolum and Eli Cook. Although they didn't have much time to spend with Paw, the parents of his great-grandchildren, Cruz, Brantley, Bentley and Channing will tell many stories of the happy times with their Paw. He chose this spot so he could watch over all the grandchildren as they play in the bottom. Visitation will be at the church on Thursday evening after 6:00pm.
