John Loren Hatfield, 71, of Pie, West Virginia passed away Tuesday, April 26, 2022 at Cabell Huntington Hospital in Huntington, WV. He was born on August 10, 1950 in Logan, WV. He was the son of Martha Virginia Miller-Hatfield and Holly G. Hatfield. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife of 31 years, Tammy Wallace-Hatfield, his aunt and uncle Nancy and Homer Hatfield, as well as his aunt and uncle Ruie and Bernal Hatfield. John was a veteran of the United States Army and a proud alumni of Marshall University. 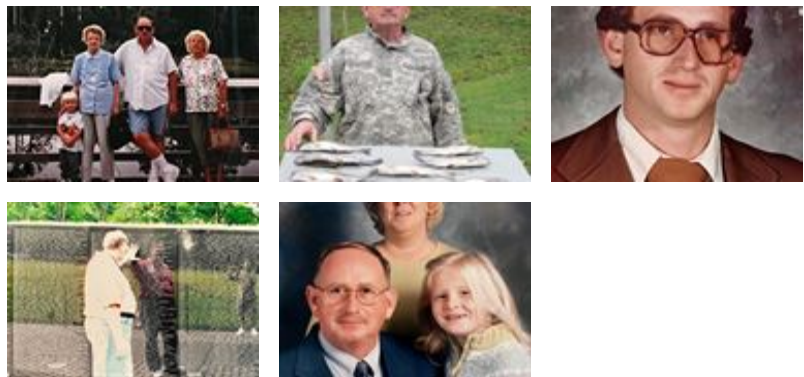
