



## Rev. Josh Enoch Hall

July 22, 1938 - August 7, 2022

Rev. Josh Enoch Hall of Lenore, passed away at 11:20pm on Sunday, August 7, 2022 at home. He was 84.

Josh was born at Road Branch on July 22, 1938, the second child of Lewis and Dora (Fletcher) Hall. He graduated from Lenore High School in 1957 and then moved to the Akron, Ohio area where he worked as a truck driver. In 1959 he married his high school sweetheart, Lola Jean Kozee. The couple have three daughters, Sandra (Paul) Parsley, Amy (Cecil) Adkins, and Marie (Jonathan) Booth. They moved back to West Virginia in 1971, where Josh continued working as a truck driver and found his true calling as a preacher. Josh became an ordained minister in 1975 and worked alongside his father at Ajax Church of Christ to minister to the community. He pastored the church from 1990 until his death. Josh made friends wherever he went and never passed up the opportunity to show kindness to a stranger.

Josh was preceded in death by his parents, Lewis and Dora, his grandparents, America (McCray) and Elijah Hall and Mary Elizabeth (Crabtree) and Josh Fletcher, sisters: Anna Sheppard, Billie Hoover, and Dorothy Long, and brothers: Elijah, James, John, and infant brother, Ronnie Hall.
