Lawrence Keith Hinkle made his journey home to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ on May 15th, 2026, while at his home in Varney, WV where he resided with his sister, Teresa Hinkle after a long battle with cancer. Keith was born on January 2, 1964, at Williamson, WV. He was the son of the late William Bill Hinkle and Emma Paige Justice Hinkle. He was also preceded in death by six brothers, Roger Lee Hinkle, Raymond Russell Hinkle, Curtis Dale Hinkle, Troy Gayle Hinkle, Billy Ray Hinkle and Bruce Edward Hinkle and his sister Ruby Hinkle.

He said, Sissy this is just a season in life that we all have to go through and he was right. He was a

brother and friend to many and will be sadly missed.

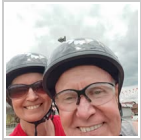
