Military Awards include but not limited to: National Defense Service Medal, Southwest Asia Service with two Bronze Stars, Kuwait Liberation Medal, Army Overseas Service Ribbon, Army Commendation Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, Army Achievement Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster. Mont was a decorated soldier who served his country with distinction. His awards and decorations are a testament to his dedication and commitment to duty. Retirement opened the door for Mont and Teresa to begin a new life chapter in Florida. They treasured their time together traveling, with their daughter, granddaughters, and great-grandchildren. 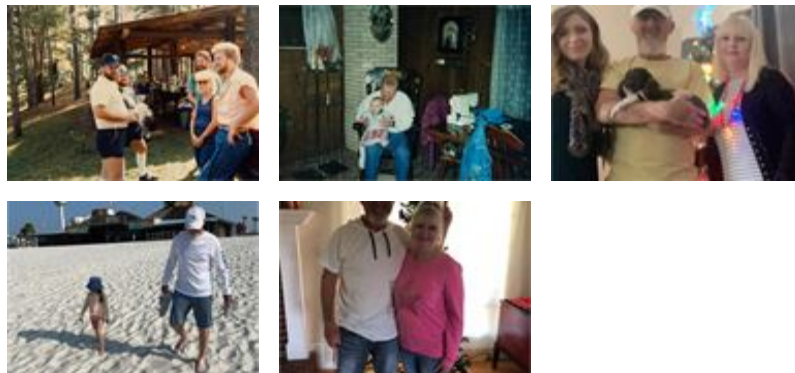
