Paul Coleman of Varney, WV died September 16, 2016 at the age of 93. He is reunited with his beloved wife of 54 years, Linnie "Linda" Coleman. He was preceded in death by his parents McKinley and Violet Coleman; brothers Mack, Tom and Ray; sisters Sonia and Chloe.
