Teddy Lee Barger, 69, of Statesville, NC, formerly of Lenore, WV, departed this life on January 7, 2019 in the Iredell Memorial Hospital in Statesville. The son of the late William Jay "Billy" and Mae Lawson Barger, Teddy was born in Holden, WV on May 21, 1949.

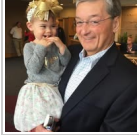

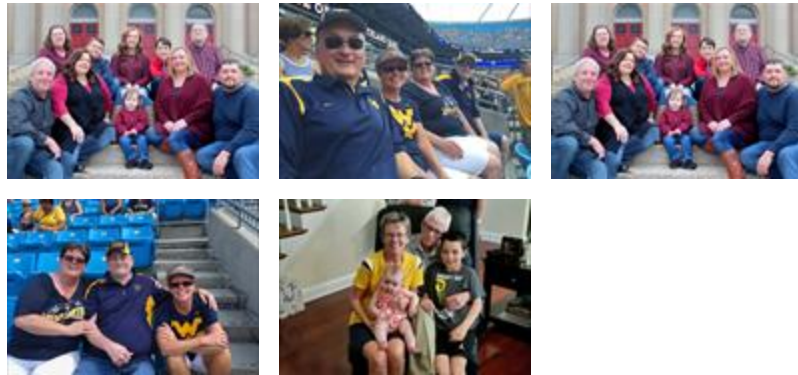
