Over the past several years, about the only reason Ted ever had for missing church were the annual camping trips to East Lynn Lake with his constantly growing family.

As a retired mechanic from the Mingo County Sheriff's Department, Ted had a knack of fixing just about anything. One thing that he can never fix is the hole that will be left in the hearts of those who knew and loved him, but he can rest easy knowing that he did everything to the glory of God.
