



## Teddy Lou Patrick

November 4, 1928 - March 27, 2022

Teddy Lou Patrick passed away peacefully at Emogene Dolin Hospice House in Huntington, West Virginia on Sunday, March 27, 2022, surrounded by her daughter, granddaughters and great grandchildren, whom she loved beyond measure. She went on to be with her Lord and Savior at the age of 93. Teddy Lou was born on November 4, 1928 in Mud Fork, West Virginia to the late Elmer (Ted) and Eva Adkins, and grew up with her seven siblings in Fez, West Virginia. She attended school in Lincoln County West Virginia, and graduated from Hamlin High School in 1948. She is preceded in death by six of her siblings; sisters, Mary Rose Floyd, Billie Mae Kaboska, and Phyllis Jean Taylor; and brothers, Golza B. Adkins, Bobby Lowell Adkins, and Franklin D. Adkins. After marrying the late Roy Elmer (Pat) Patrick, Sr. in 1949, Teddy Lou and her husband welcomed three children into their loving family. They made their home and raised their children in Delbarton, West Virginia. Her son, Dewy Michael Patrick, tragically preceded her in death. Giving her life to the Lord at an early age, Teddy Lou and her family made their home at the Elk Creek Community Church of God. She served the people of Elk Creek Community Church in many ways throughout her time there, including teaching Sunday school and baking and selling pies with her sister-in-law, the late Lula Ferrell, to build their new church. Later in life, she joined Regional Church of God, where she was a member until the time of her passing. Anyone who knew Teddy Lou, knew she loved Jesus, her family and gardening, and in that order. She loved going to church and being in the

house of God to sing and hear the word. If you sat next to her, she'd grip your hand and pray, squeeze you with a hug, and give you candy from her purse. Her family and their accomplishments were a constant source of pride for her, and she loved to talk and share with everyone about her children and grandchildren and their education and careers. Gardening wasn't a hobby for her, it was her life's work. She turned the ground she had with love and patience, planted her peas early, and was grateful for every year she had to grow food and put it up for her family. When it was time to pick the peas, string the beans or shuck the corn, she did it with a heart of gratefulness, and preserved it all. During late summer, she loved to brag about how many quarts of food she'd put away and she'd ask you how many you got from your garden. If you'd put up more than her, she'd be proud of you and brag about you to everyone. Traveling and reading were two of her favorite pastimes. Just last year she spent several weeks with her granddaughter and family in Florida. She loved spending time in the mountains of Tennessee and hopping on a boat, climbing up in the truck, or riding the four-wheeler to go blackberry or apple picking with the grandkids. Her personal library was donated to a local organization just before her passing. Teddy Lou leaves to cherish her loving memory, two of her children, daughter Tammy and Keith Hess, who lovingly cared for her in their home for the past 7 years, and son Roy and Peggy Patrick, Jr.; her four grandchildren, granddaughters Stacy and Reda Shihadeh, Lauren and Bo Copley, Mallory Patrick, and grandson Ryan Patrick; her eight great-grandchildren, Norah Shihadeh, Laila Shihadeh, Zayd Shihadeh, Elliott Copley, Charlotte Copley, Merritt Copley, Natalie Evans, and Conner Patrick; and her beloved sister, Jewel (Jerri) and Bob Huffman; and her loyal canine companion, London. 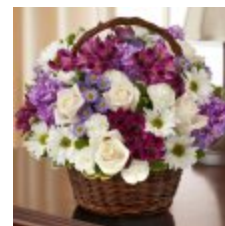
